School Uniform

This consists of:

- Red Parklands sweatshirt with crest.
- White polo shirt
- Grey trousers, skirt, pinafore dress, shorts or a red and white checked summer dress in the summer.

Long hair must be tied up and hair bands should be in school colours.

Shoes

A pair of flat black plain/sensible shoes.

These should be sturdy and enclosed.

Open-toe sandals are **NOT** permitted in the Summer.

Physical Education

Parklands PE shirt or white t-shirt

A change of shoes are needed for outdoor games.

Red shorts

Optional plain black tracksuit for outdoor games.

PE kit should be kept in a drawstring bag which is clearly named.

Children will still go outside in light rain.

Jewellery should not be worn in school (with the exception of stud earrings). Please provide tape to cover earrings in PE or remove them in advance. If watches are worn they are **NOT** the responsibility of the school. No Smart watches are allowed.

Please make sure that your child's clothing is **MARKED WITH THEIR NAME** either by using name tapes or permanent marker pen.

Second-hand uniform is available from the Parklands School Association.

Improving School Attendance

Improving our School Attendance

Below are some useful reminders of what parents and carers must do to support the school and what we will do as a school.

What YOU must do:

Try to telephone the school before 8.30am each day of your child's absence.

Tell the school in advance of any medical appointments and bring in appointment cards/letters/texts.

If you are not sure whether your child is well enough to attend school, send them in anyway as they often perk up on arrival.

Have a backup plan for if your child misses transport, call on a family member, neighbour or friend.

If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance then talk to us as a first step so we can help!

What WE will do:

Check your child's attendance every day.

Phone home to discuss your child's attendance with you.

Invite you into school for attendance meetings if we are concerned.

If we cannot establish a reason for absence, then we may make a welfare home visit.



Reading at Home

This week we have launched our new reading diaries with the children.

Please read with your child for 10 minutes a day and record this in the diary.

We are looking forward to seeing how many children read at least 5 days a week.
